We are grateful to the pastor, Fr. Fred Guthrie, and the parishioners of the Immaculate Conception Church in Salem, Ma. for donating to us a relic of our patron saint, St. Isidore the Farmer. While doing renovations in their Church, the relic was found in a marble altar which would be used no longer.

The relic has been encased in a reliquary in the former holy oils repository and placed next to the statue of St. Isidore.

A special ceremony for the blessing of the reliquary and repository will take place on May 14 when we celebrate the feast of our patron saint.
